Registration fee to Junior Braves	\$135 (1st child in family) \$120 (2nd child in family) \$105 (3rd child in family) \$70 (for training partners only)	This is paid online and is to be paid prior to the first tournament of the season. The registration link will be opened after all teams have been selected and announced.
Uniforms (polo shirt, training singlet, warm up top, playing shorts, tracksuit pants, hoodie)	\$150—\$250	The amount is dependent on the level of competition of the player in the selected side, and their level of current Braves uniform.
Tournaments	\$120-\$200 per tournament (average for 2016/17 season)	The cost is split between all members of the team. Team managers will provide a costing sheet prior to each tournament. Cost is dependent on location, accommodation, team set up, etc.
VJBL (U14, U16, U18 Div 1 teams only)	\$550	All "1" side players in the VJBL competition are required to obtain a sponsor. This contributes towards season costs.

Victorian Junior Basketball League (VJBL)

Bendigo Bank Junior Braves "First" sides compete in the VJBL in Melbourne and throughout Victoria.

Junior Braves teams train once a week, with VJBL teams training twice a week. BBA pays for the 2nd training venue if this is not at Bendigo Stadium. If a VJBL team wish to train on a 3rd night, it is the responsibility of the team to book and pay for this training venue.

Where possible, teams train at Bendigo Stadium on Sunday's, however at times outside venues are utilised. Where Bendigo Stadium is unavailable on a Sunday, Sports Office staff are responsible for making these bookings, and BBA pays for this.

If a team wishes to train outside of these training days, it is the responsibility of the team to book and pay for the venue hire.
