WHAT MEASURES HAVE YOU PUT IN PLACE FOR MANAGING ENTRY AND EXIT POINTS, ADJUSTMENTS TO ACTIVITY TIMINGS AND MAINTAINING PHYSICAL DISTANCING OF PEOPLE?

Participants have been asked to arrive no more than 15 minutes prior to their scheduled game time. Participants must enter via the designated entry and exit doors which coincides with the court number of their scheduled game. External signage above the concourse doors will specify the door to enter. Sanitiser must be used upon entry of the Stadium. Participants are to arrive at the stadium ready to compete.

Teams must immediately vacate the venue on completion of their game and exit the premises to allow the next group to enter the venue.

Game time slots will be an allocated 1 hour time slot, this will allow for the required cleaning and also the safe change over of games. This will also reduce traffic through the venue.

All spectators will be required to remain in a designated spectator area whilst social distancing. Spectators will not be allowed near the players bench whilst in the stadium.

HOW WILL YOU MANAGE OCCUPANCY LIMITS AND COMPLIANCE AGAINST RESTRICTION LEVELS AT THE VENUE? We will be following all Basketball Victoria return to play guidelines in relation to occupancy limits and restrictions. We have asked that there is to be only one spectator per athlete to ensure that we stay within occupancy limit under Green COVIDsafe.

HOW WILL YOU ENSURE THAT YOUR TEAMS AND OFFICIALS HAVE ACCESS TO HAND SANITISER DURING TRAINING OR COMPETITION?

Hand sanitiser must be available on all score benches for teams, referees and score table officials to use during game and as required.

HOW WILL YOU ENSURE APPROPRIATE CLEANING AND SANITISATION OF EQUIPMENT – BALLS, LAPTOP, SCORE

All scoring laptops/tablets, score benches, seating, and scoreboard

BENCH, PLAYER BENCH FOR EACH GAME OR ACTIVITY?

controllers are to be sanitised in between games, to reduce the risk of transmission from one group to another by the BSO.

Stadium employees will sanitise surfaces such as door handles, taps, seating, during competition breaks between Group A and Group B.

Courts will be cleaned daily as required.

To continue a safe environment for all children there will be regular cleaning and monitoring of courts and ensuring spectators are following social distancing rules and regulations.

HOW ARE YOU ARE PROVIDING A SAFE ENVIRONMENT FOR STAFF, VOLUNTEERS AND OFFICIALS?

To continue a safe environment for staff, volunteers and officials we will be monitoring the situation and providing regular training for all to ensure that we are complying to all regulations and guidelines.

WHAT PROTOCOLS DO YOU HAVE IN PLACE FOR PEOPLE WHO PRESENT WITH SYMPTOMS CONSISTENT WITH COVID-19 (FEVER OR RESPIRATORY SYMPTOMS SUCH AS COUGH, SORE THROAT AND SHORTNESS OF BREATH)?

We have asked that anyone who is currently ill or showing COVID-19 symptoms to not attend games however if there is someone present with symptoms we will have an isolation room available and we will contact DHHS and follow the advice given.

HOW WILL YOU MAINTAIN AN

When you enter the stadium, you will be

required to scan a QR code. This QR code will take you to a link that will require you to input your name, mobile number, and what court you are playing on or spectating for that timeslot. This proof of scan must be shown to a biosafety officer upon entry.

All children must be accompanied by parent/coach or team Manager to ensure processes are followed due to COVID19.
