



Retirement of Braves Singlet - Criteria

The following process is to be completed to consider for Retirement of Braves Women & Men Playing Singlets

1. A written nomination must be made to the Bendigo Basketball Association Awards Committee.
2. The Nomination must contain the details of the name and playing number that is making the nomination.
3. The written nomination must include a reason as to why they have nominated the retired player and must include documented evidence to support the nomination to have that players Singlet retired.
4. The nomination must be signed by the proponent.
5. When a nomination is received by Bendigo Basketball Association Awards committee the committee will assess the application against the following criteria and the nominated player must meet at least 5 of the following criteria.
 - 5.1. The nominated player must have been retired from playing for a period exceeding 12 months,
 - 5.2. Played more than 200 Senior Games for the Bendigo Braves. (SEABL, SEBL, CBA, ABA, NBL1),
 - 5.3. Received multiple league awards over multiple seasons,
 - 5.4. Received multiple club awards over multiple seasons,
 - 5.5. Service to the Bendigo Basketball Association,
 - 5.6. Been a large contributor to the Bendigo Basketball Community on and off the court,
 - 5.7. Must have had a positive impact in the Bendigo community,
 - 5.8. Players Conduct on and off the court must be taken into consideration,

6. The nomination will be listed as an agenda item for consideration at the following Bendigo Basketball Association Awards committee meeting.
7. The Awards Committee will then review the nomination and provide a recommendation the Bendigo Basketball Association Board for approval.
8. When approving or declining the nomination, the committee members may seek the opinion of that players' coaches, sponsors, community stakeholders and others involved at Bendigo Basketball at that time.
9. The Awards committee will then decide on the validity and merits of the nomination and make recommendation to the Bendigo Basketballs Association board.
10. The nomination together with a recommendation by the Awards Committee will be forwarded to the Board of the B.B.A. for their consideration and decision. at the next B.B.A. Board meeting.
11. If the nomination is declined the Awards Committee will within 28 days inform the proponent in writing of the decision including an explanation.
12. If the nomination is approved the retired player will receive the following acknowledgements from the Bendigo Basketball Association.
 - 13.1 Large Banner for display and will depict the players Name, Number, Nickname.
 - 13.2 The retired player may offer the retired number to a current player
 - 13.3 The Club will supply a framed poster to the retired player acknowledging the contributions to the Braves Basketball Association.
13. The cost associated with the retirement of a player's singlet is to be paid by the B.B.A.
14. Criteria updates for player singlet retirements are to be approved by the B.B.A. If amendments are required, it is to be put in writing and forwarded to the B.B.A. for approval. All amendments are to be documented and dated.
